WHY JET OWNERSHIP MAY MAKE MORE SENSE THAN A JET CARD



OWNING YOUR OWN PLANE IS MORE COST-EFFECTIVE THAN JET CARDS OR CHARTERING

A typical heavy jet card costs about \$10K per flight hour. Ventura owners pay about \$4400 per hour to fly on our Challenger 604s.

Last year, Ventura 604 owners saw an average return of over \$300K – enough to cover 68 hours of flight. Depending on usage, some owners don't pay out of pocket for their annual flying.

GET A CONSISTENT EXPERIENCE EVERY TIME

Most jet card companies don't have their own committed fleet and are forced to source aircraft from the marketplace, often using language like "Challenger or similar" to give them flexibility when sourcing. As a Ventura owner, you'll always be on your aircraft type and have access to all of the Challengers in our fleet at the same owner rate.

Utilizing "bonus depreciation", some owners qualify to depreciate their aircraft by 80% in their first year after ownership. This could mean over \$2M of tax deferral in your first year of ownership.
